The Domaine is spread over 20 hectares in the best terroirs, amongst them, four grand crus: Les Clos, Les Preuses, Vaudesir and Les Blanchots, and four premiers crus: Montée de Tonnerre, Mont-de-Milieu, Fourchaume and Vaillons.

Established in Nuits-Saint-Georges, in the heart of Burgundy, Domaine Faiveley owns more than 120 hectares of vines including 11 Grands Crus and 21 Premiers Crus.
